Pursuant to City of Lynn Ordinance, a license must be obtained before keeping any coin operated amusement devices on one's premises. A Coin-Operated License must be obtained before any vendor machines are placed on the property. Licenses expire May 31st annually.

Steps to complete for License:


1. Application is based on how many machines and Class type
2. \$25.00 (four year expiration)
3. Class I \$30.00 per machine
4. Class II \$75.00 per machine
5. Class III \$125.00 per machine
6. Notify Ward Councilor

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF AMUSEMENT
DEVICES WHETHER COIN OPERATED OR NOT, IN THE CITY OF LYNN, EXCLUDING
COIN-OPERATED MUSIC MACHINES

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Lynn and by the authority of the same, as follows, to wit:

SECTION 1. The Ordinance Amending the Ordinance Regulating the Use of Amusement Devices Whether Coin-Operated or Not, in the City of Lynn, Excluding Coin-Operated Music Machines, as heretofore amended, is hereby further amended to include under Section 1, the following:

- N. It shall be illegal to have on the premises any multi-coined operated machines for the purpose of advancing the odds for the number of free games or prizes. The fine for violation of this will be \$100.00 per day, after notification.
- O. Any machine which is in violation of this ordinance may be confiscated from the premises by order of the License Committee of the City Council, by the Vice-Squad or by any Police Officer during the normal performance of his duties.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect thirty-one (31) days after its final approval as adopted and advertised.

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- D. A license for the premises to operate automatic amusement devices in the City of Lynn shall be required.
- E. Applications shall be filed with the City Clerk to be presented to the Committee on Licenses of the City Council. The applicant shall be the owner or manager of the establishment requesting the license.
- F. Licenses shall be issued by the License Committee of the City Council with a majority vote of the City Council.
- G. There shall be no more than one (1) license not to exceed two (2) machines per premises except in compliance with Section 1H of this Ordinance.
- H. Permits may be issued for more than two (2) but not to exceed four (4) automatic amusement devices, to places that have Certificates of Public Assembly issued by the Building Department of the City of Lynn.
- I. Automatic Amusement Devices licensed under this ordinance shall be so installed on the premises described in the application as to be in open view at all times while in operation and shall at all times be available for inspection. All machines shall have the Owners name, address and telephone number attached in clear view.
- J. Any applicant who has been denied permission shall not be allowed to re-apply for the same premises within the calendar year.
- K. No person keeping or offering for operation or allowing to be kept or offered for operation any automatic amusement device shall permit the same to be used for the purpose of gambling.
- L. No machine (s) shall be operated by persons Sixteen (16) years of age or younger while Lynn Schools are in session from the hours of 7:00 A.M. to 2:30 P.M.. No machine (s) shall be operated within a 500' foot radius of a school while school is in session from the hours of 7:00 A.M. to 2:30 P.M. with the exception of premises licensed to serve alcoholic beverages.
- M. Any machine (s) which is in violation of this ordinance may be confiscated from the premises by order of the License Committee of the City Council or the City Clerk

SECTION 2. For the purpose of clarification, an Arcade shall consist of any establishment in excess of four (4) automatic amusement devices which sole business is that of amusement devices. Public Hearing is required before the City Council prior to the granting of a license.

SECTION 3. Special consent may be granted after a Public Hearing before the City Council for a game room, activity room or function room or hall that shall have an associated use of a business such as a Bowling Alley, Restaurant, Motel or Hotel, private or public club. These premises shall have in excess of four (4) but not to exceed ten (10) automatic amusement devices. Licenses granted under this Section must be in compliance with Section 1 H of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. Every vendor or Owner of Automatic Amusement Devices licensed in the City of Lynn shall on the last day of May each year file with the City Clerk a statement listing the principals of the Corporation or Business. The fee for each vendor for filing shall be \$25.00 annually.

* SECTION 5. Any vendor violating any provision of this ordinance shall be subject to an automatic thirty (30) day suspension of his licenses for all machines licensed in the City of Lynn. Said suspension shall result in machines being removed from all premises. All licensees shall be prohibited from conditioning the playing of Automatic Amusement Devices.

SECTION 6. Licenses may be revoked for cause by the Issuing Authority. Any license revoked shall be granted a hearing before the Committee on Licenses upon written request. A hearing before the Committee on Licenses shall be required before reinstatement of any license.

* SECTION 7. Any violation of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) per offense, after having been notified of the offense by the Issuing Authority, the City Clerk or the Vice Squad of the Police Department.

SECTION 8. The invalidity of any section or provision of this ordinance shall not invalidate any other section or provision thereof.

SECTION 9. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 10. This ordinance shall take effect thirty-one (31) days after its final approval as adopted and advertised.

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

- D. Any applicant who has been denied permission shall not be allowed to reapply for the same premises within the calendar year.
- E. It shall be illegal to have on the premises any multi-coined operated machines for the purposes of advancing the odds for the number of free games or prizes. The fine for violation of this will be \$100.00 per day.
- F. Any machine which is in violation of this ordinance may be confiscated from the premises by order of the License Committee of the City Council, by the Vice-Squad or by any Police Officer during the normal performance of his duties.

SECTION 3. Any violation of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00 per day for each offense) after having been notified of the offense by the Issuing Authority, the City Clerk and or any Police Officer in the normal performance of his duties.

SECTION 4. For the purpose of clarification, an Arcade shall consist of any establishment in excess of four (4) amusement devices whether coin-operated or not. The fee shall be One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per year. Permits shall be renewable on the last day of May of each year. Billiards, sippio etc. are considered amusement devices.

SECTION 5. Special consent may be granted after a public hearing for a game room, activity room or function room or hall that shall have an associated use of a business such as: Bowling Alley, Restaurant, Motel or Hotel, private or public clubs. For clarification these premises will have in excess of four (4) and not to exceed Ten (10) amusement devices, whether coin-operated or not. These businesses must have certificates of public assembly issued by the Building Department of the City of Lynn. The license fee shall be One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per year. Permits shall become renewable on the last day of May each year.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Lynn and by the authority of the same, as follows, to wit:-

SECTION 1. An ordinance establishing an ordinance regulating the use of amusement devices whether coin-operated or not in the City of Lynn, excluding coin-operated music machines, is hereby further amended and said ordinance shall provide as follows:

- A. A License for the premises to operate amusement devices whether coin-operated or not in the City of Lynn shall be required.
- B. Applications shall be filed with the License Committee of the City Council.
- C. Licenses shall be issued by the License Committee of the City Council with full approval of the Council.
- D. The License Committee shall have the authority to grant no more than one (1) license to each applicant, not to exceed two (2) machines per premises.
- E. The license fee shall be Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per year. Permits shall become renewable on the last day of May of each year.

SECTION 2. Licenses may be revoked for cause by the Issuing Authority Any license revoked must have a hearing by the City Council Committee on License before reinstatement.

- A. Renewals may be granted by the City Clerk's Office without coming before the City Council.
- B. Permits may be issued for more than two (2) but not to exceed four (4) amusement devices whether coin-operated or not, to places that have certificates of public assembly issued by the Building Department of the City of Lynn at an additional cost of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00).



 to exceed four (4) coin-operated machines to places
 that have certificates of public assembly issued by
 the Building Department of the City of Lynn for
 thirty (30) or more persons.

Ordered that IN THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF COIN-OPERATED AMUSEMENT DEVICES IN THE CITY OF LYNN EXCLUDING COIN-OPERATED MUSIC MACHINE.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Lynn and by the authority of the same as follows, to wit:-

SECTION 1. It shall require a license for the premises to operate coin-operated amusement devices in the City of Lynn. The fee shall be \$5.00 per year for each license. Permits may be issued only to places that have certificates of Public Assembly issued by the Building Department for 30 persons or more. These permits shall become renewable on the last day of May of each year. Licenses will be issued by the City Clerk.

SECTION 2. Licenses may be revoked for cause by the Issuing Authority. Any license revoked must have a hearing by the City Council Committee on Licenses before reinstatement.

SECTION 3. Any violation of this ordinance will carry a fine of \$50.00 for each day for each offense after having been notified of offense by the Issuing Authority.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption and approval, after advertising as adopted.
