**IN THE YEAR TWO THOUSAND TWELVE
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO CREATING
A HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION IN THE CITY OF LYNN**

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Lynn and by the authority of the same as follows, to wit: -

SECTION 1:00

The ordinance relative to Creating a Human Rights Commission Section 4:00 – Membership states: “The Commission shall consist of twelve (12) members, six of whom shall be appointed by the Mayor and six (6) of whom shall be appointed by the Lynn City Council in accordance with their rules, to serve without compensation, at least one of whom shall be an attorney from the City’s Law Department” is hereby amended.

The amended ordinance shall read as follows:

The Commission shall consist of twelve (12) members, six of whom shall be appointed by the Mayor and six (6) of whom shall be appointed by the Lynn City Council in accordance with their rules, to serve without compensation, at least one of whom shall be an attorney from the City’s Law Department/member shall be a non-voting member of the Human Rights Commission.

SECTION 2:00

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3:00

This Ordinance shall take effect thirty-one (31) days after its final approval as adopted and advertised.
