IN THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING THE ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO STREET AND SIDEWALK EXCAVATIONS IN
THE CITY OF LYNN

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Lynn and by the authority of the same as follows, to wit:-

SECTION 1. The Ordinance pertaining to street and sidewalk excavations in the City of Lynn is hereby amended by deleting the existing Section 2 and inserting the following new Section 2:

SECTION 2. Contractors shall file with the Department of Public Works prior to the issuance of said permit, a bond in an amount and form satisfactory to the City Solicitor, together with a certificate of insurance naming said contractor and the City of Lynn as co-insured. The Certificate of Insurance must include general public liability* insurance to cover claims for bodily injury, death or property damage in any manner arising out of the work of the contractor and the City of Lynn as their respective interest may appear of not less than \$300,000 with respect to bodily injury or death to any one person, not less than \$500,000 with respect to any one incident, and not less than \$300,000 with respect to property damage.

All insurance and bonds shall be written by insurers which are qualified to do business in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. All insurance required to be maintained shall be in form and substance satisfactory to the City Solicitor. The City Solicitor may require additional limits amounts and coverage depending upon the size and scope of the subject project.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect thirty-one (31) days after its final adoption as advertised.



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AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO STREET AND SIDEWALK EXCAVATIONS IN THE CITY OF LYNN

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Lynn and by the authority of the same "as follows to wit: -

SECTION 1. All street and sidewalk excavations done within the City of Lynn shall require a permit issued by the Department of Public Works.

SECTION 2. Contractors shall post an adequate and sufficient bond so as to be responsible for the condition of the pavement and the settlement in the area excavated for a period of thirty-six (36) months from the date of final inspection and approval.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect thirty-one (31) days after its final adoption as advertised.
